seas high-speed railway. But until 2018, no one had ever traveled that fast on a bicycle powered only by human movement. And until only a few years before, no woman dared try.

LIGHT Helmets arrive in Carlsbad

On September 1, 2018, Safer Sports, LLC acquired the assets of SG Helmets, the 5th largest manufacturer of football helmets in the world and a longtime leader in sports helmet safety technology. Safer Sports, LLC has rebranded itself as "LIGHT Helmets." LIGHT Helmets' first product will be a completely redesigned football helmet (the LS1) using much lighter, yet stronger materials for both the outer shell, liner, and face mask from technology and manufacturing techniques used by the military as well as the aviation and auto racing industries. It is set for release in the Spring of 2019. "Football and other contact sports are being heavily scrutinized today - by worried parents, players at all levels, and anxious league executives – over player safety and concussion concerns." said Nick Esayian, CEO of LIGHT Helmets. "By significantly cutting helmet weight while exceeding

Team approach helps businesses

Six years ago the five North County cities that cluster along state Route 78 decided that banding together as an economic force was preferable to battling each other, and launched an economic initiative called **Innovate78**. It was based on the simple concept that the five cities – Carlsbad, Escondido, Oceanside, San Marcos and Vista – would serve their residents and businesses better through collaboration instead of competition.

North San Diego County is home to a wide array of businesses that specialize in high tech, life sciences, action sports, manufacturing and other core industries, and the region has grown into its own as a vibrant economic engine. Cooperating to expand and nurture these industries helps attract new businesses and retain existing ones. Competing could drive businesses away and ignores the fact that while a business may be located in one city, their employees, customers, vendors and suppliers are regionally based.

The five cities have collaborated on several fronts, such as helping a business that outgrows its space and cannot find adequate space in its home city. When that happens, we put that firm in contact our neighbors in Innovate78 to see if one of them can accommodate them. None of us likes to lose a business, but keeping the company and its jobs along the 78 Corridor is preferable to seeing them leave North County for Orange County or Los Angeles.

Another way the cities work as a team is by filing a joint response with the Governor's Office of Economic Development to present the region as an attractive place to do business. Typically cities file individually. Speaking with one voice has helped raise the profile of North County. We also work together to help businesses obtain *California Competes* tax credits to add new jobs. In 2018, our Innovate78 efforts helped four companies

win \$1 million in tax credits, which will add 44 jobs to the region over the next five years.

"Traditionally in San Diego, anything north of state Route 56 was like another galaxy to a lot of people in San Diego," recalled Michelle Geller, the City of Escondido Economic Development Manager. "It was very far away."

Geller said that in its early days Innovate78 focused on developing a brand and raising the region's profile, and has progressed through the years. Now the focus is attracting and supporting business startups to spur job growth.

This collaborative attitude came into play recently when the Brewers Supply Group was seeking to locate a warehouse in San Diego County. San Diego County is a leader in the craft beer industry, and BSG, as it is known, wanted a San Diego location. It contacted one of the cities and soon it was in touch with three of us, all willing to help the firm find the best place in North County. The firm selected Oceanside, and the county's entire craft brewing industry, from Oceanside to Imperial Beach, has benefited.

San Marcos Economic Development Manager Tess Sangster noted that one unseen advantage of the Innovate78 partnership is that the five managers meet and exchange ideas on how to help businesses with specific problems, which would not happen in a competitive situation.

"It's nice on an attraction and retention basis as well, because I can say to a firm that this a region where we're all working together and we want you in North County," Sangster said. "It's less about the individual cities. This is an area with a strong economy for all five cities and we have the numbers to prove it. We're way stronger together than individually, and it's really positive."

There's the saying "one for all and all for one," and Innovate78 demonstrates that. By working together we have raised our region's profile collectively, which in turn has raised each city's profile individually.

Celebrating our green



slipstream created by the pace car. Failure to have kept up with the pace car would have meant catastrophe. She would have been knocked off the bike by the wind with only a motorcycle helmet and leather/lycra suit to protect her.

World record in hand, Mueller-Korenek isn't ready to hang up the bike just yet. "Anyone that pushes limits always has the curiosity for the edge." Mueller-Korenek feels, however, that she found that edge in her record setting ride. So this year she will chase a different type of record - 75mph without the slipstream provided by a pace car and on a recumbent bicycle with its own unique challenges because of the reclined riding position.

A CEO at age 20, Mueller-Korenek is a life-long business woman. She recalls "I started at age four by emptying out the wastebaskets" of her family's security business. Mueller-Korenek was a national champion cyclist in her youth but stepped away from racing at age 18 as she focused on building

the business and raising her sons. Ten years later, and motivated to become active again she purchased a gym membership at a silent auction and later satisfied her competitive streak by competing in marathons. However, she realized she had "unfinished business" on the bike. Mueller-Korenek's coach and record cyclist himself, John Howard, suggested she pursue a speed record that he once held. "Men had been setting records since 1899, but no woman had ever tried" she says.

Mueller-Korenek believes that parallels exist between sports and business. "Any activity with a competitive atmosphere that forces you to push your limits can help you in a business environment, whether it is facing a difficult conversation or setting higher goals for your business. I think you would find a high percentage

Photos by Matt Ben Stone of CEOs who are active in some way," says Mueller-Korenek, who credits her cycling coach for motivating her and holding her accountable. "It's the same in business, whether you answer to a board of directors, an advisory board, or a business coach."

Her competitive spirit is a key advantage at a time when the traditional firms like Rancho Santa Fe Security are facing pressure from telecommunications providers as well as internet based-firms offering monitoring products. Mueller-Korenek finds great value in the relationships developed in-person like the ones she has built through the Chamber. "There will always be larger players in our industry, but there is benefit to being local. Customers want to do business with someone they know, especially when you're trusting someone with your security.'

Noting the security industry is male-dominated just like speed cycling, Mueller-Korenek says her upbringing instilled confidence. "I never let being a minority limit me. My father taught me to do what I wanted with no barriers and no shame". Women's empowerment to her means having the same opportunities as men – "just give me the ability to try".

While Mueller-Korenek's parents were both competitive athletes, she believes there is tremendous value in becoming active at any age. "The investment of time that parents make in athletics has a double benefit – the health benefit along with the time spent together even while driving to a meet". For children and adults alike she advises "Explore your competitive spirit. Keep trying to find something you like and give yourself the ability to fail. Just because you find you're not good at something it doesn't mean there isn't value in the journey towards what you can excel in."

San Francisco or downtown San Diego. We like being here for that family atmosphere. There's also still a lot of nature here and that's rejuvenating. I love downtown Carlsbad - we have so many more restaurants and boutiques popping up. It's just a nice place to live not to mention the weather is great. You're only a couple of hours from the desert and the mountains. It's like living and working in vacationland."

Breaking barriers beat by beat

I asked Sheppard Missett to take me back to her beginnings in the late 60s, when there was not really a fitness industry as we know today, and just a few women venturing into business within the field. Sheppard Missett was teaching a Jazz Dance class in Chicago back then when she noticed her students were not staying in her class. "It bugged me. I wondered what I was doing wrong. I thought the best way to find out was to ask. That was a little bit scary

because it is possible you may not like the answer. They told me the class was too difficult and that they didn't want to be a professional dancer. They just wanted to look like one."

The evolution

With that information, Sheppard Missett knew she had to make changes. "I made it fun and easy to follow, turned them away from the mirror, and gave them lots of positive encouragement." Soon enough those adjustments worked out. "After the second class I did see the potential for bigger classes. The first class I had 15 people, the second class I had 30, and the next I had 60. However, I didn't think of it as a business at that time, just an opportunity for more people to experience dance."

Following her passion and better weather, in 1977 Sheppard Smith opened her first corporate Jazzercise office right here in Carlsbad. It was then that right before her eves the company's growth exploded. "It never dawned on me that 'wow this is big' until maybe the late 70s, early 80s. I was sitting in

invigorate more participation form Jazzercise's franchisees and embracing new technology such as creating their website.

"In the first decade of the new millennium, we instituted new business plans. In this decade we are developing more program ideas, facility options, and new ways to think of instructors, and create different points of entry for people of all backgrounds.

There are always cues telling you what next steps are needed. And then you decide how you want to handle them. And it's fun. It's exciting. I have incredible people around me. I feel like all I have to do is say 'let's do this' and let them run with it. My daughter (Shanna Missett Nelson) is an incredible leader in the company as well. She's very creative. The idea is to keep being proactive and moving forward."

Keeping on moving

I asked Sheppard Missett what her vision is for the company in the next few years, her answer summarized in three words: "To keep going!". With customers who are loyal fans and have been Jazzercising 20, 30, 40 years, Sheppard Missett knows she needs to continue to fulfill their needs, while at the same time attract a new audience. Sheppard Missett also has the commitment to lift up other women who want to start their own franchise or business. "We'll continue to come up with new class programs and unique ways of communication. We're working on video on demand which will reach a different group of people, but also

turn helps you sustain your business. There are three important areas - striving for the mind/body/spirit connection will give you clarity, serenity, opportunity and energy. 1. You have to keep your mind questioning and educated. **2.** You have to keep your

body fit by exercising and eating properly, getting check-ups, and paying attention to your wellbeing. And...

3. You have to feed your spirit – keep joy in your life. Give back. Three ways to do that are through volunteering, mentoring, and philanthropy. When you give back, and put joy in your life, you will feel better, look better, age better, and have a better quality of life."

After 50 years, there's something this successful woman entrepreneur carries with her wherever she goes that energizes her. "The memories I cherish the most are the relationships and the comments I get from people who have been touched by Jazzercise in one way or another. Maybe it's just helped them to feel better. But there's more to our program than just fitness. There's a community. I get letters from people from around the globe who are so grateful for that sense of community, who wake up and look forward to going to their 'happy place'. When people tell me Jazzercise is their 'happy place,' it fuels my motivation to keep making it better and better."

Lifting other women up

At a time when women are feeling even more empowered to start businesses Sheppard Missett is a living example that success can be long lasting. "The first piece of advice I'd give any woman is to do something you're passionate about. Passion enables you to work really hard because you will need a great work ethic as well as patience, perseverance, and courage. Passion helps you listen to your gut. It also helps you to be okay with being different because that means you are unique and special. Secondly don't be afraid to change. Lastly – nurture and feed your inner self by working on that balance between mind, body and spirit."

in helmet weight, up to 60 percent compared to some competitive helmets. While the majority of football helmets used today weigh between four-to-six pounds, LIGHT Helmets' football helmet will weigh just over two-and-a-half pounds depending on how they are configured. "The more weight you put into impact, the more kinetic energy is generated and the more potentially dangerous those impacts become," said Justin Bert, COO at LIGHT Helmets. "Our focus on reduced weight will not only improve player performance, but also reduce fatigue and injury. Football deserves this helmet and in the coming months we will be transitioning this same technology to other contact sport helmets."

LIGHT Helmets has a diverse advisory board – including Dr. Shawn Evans, Chief of Staff from Scripps and Dr. Tal David, former head physician of the Chargers. LIGHT Helmets is fully engaged with the NFL and other safety entities

After an initial focus on lightweight football helmets, LIGHT Helmets will expand in the hockey, lacrosse and baseball markets. LIGHT Helmets also has plans to revolutionize helmets for a wide range of professional industries.

LIGHT Helmets' first helmet, the LS1, will be released in the spring of 2019.

Haynes reflective at final report to community

Cal State San Marcos President Karen Haynes reflected on her long, distinguished tenure and highlighted the university's growth and accomplishments over the years during her 15th and final Report to the Community address on Feb. 7.

As part of the annual event on campus, it was revealed that CSUSM raised \$55,035,210 in its first comprehensive fundraising campaign, Forward Together, blowing past its goal of \$50 million.

Haynes initiated the Report to the Community address in 2005, and it has become an annual tradition in which she spotlights CSUSM's achievements to a broad cross section of regional business, nonprofit, education and government leadership. The sold-out event this year featured more than 600 attendees.

Haynes, the longestserving president in the California State University system, announced last fall that she will be retiring at the end of June along with her husband, Jim Mickelson, the director of ACE Scholars Services, CSUSM's cutting-edge program for former foster youth.

'While there have been many beginnings for us during these 15 years, as our retirement approaches, farewells are less common," Haynes said. "However.

what remains for us, in our crystal-clear vision, is our optimism for the future of this very special place. The teamwork within our university, the partnerships with external entities. These provide us with a great source of satisfaction, but more importantly, they support our certainty that the successful trajectory of this campus is assured."

Haynes told the story of how she and Mickelson first visited CSUSM in the summer of 2003 after she had been nominated for the presidency. She said they examined regional demographics, traveled to North County to explore the area, and walked the campus incognito.

"What we discovered was a place full of opportunities and potential," Haynes said. "I knew that my preferred leadership style was not to be a maintenance leader and hoped that my predilection for visioning and growing organizations might be a fit. So I threw my fuchsia suit into the pool of nominees and, well, 151/2 years later, I can say to you that I was right.

A big part of the legacy of Haynes will be the undertaking and success of Forward Together. Under Haynes' leadership, CSUSM not only reached its \$50 million goal, it exceeded it by more than 10 percent.

"What President Haynes and I both knew was that we could pull together a great campaign, that non-alumni would contribute, and that everyone would want to be on this winning team," Jack Raymond, the chair of the CSUSM Foundation Board, said before announcing the final Forward Together total.

Raymond also announced that the campaign featured 9,290 unique donors and 6.629 first-time donors.

Carlsbad Unified's STEAM girls

As more opportunities arise for women to pursue careers in Science, Technology, Engineering, the Arts, and Mathematics (STEAM), **Carlsbad Unified School District** takes pride in its new generation of STEAM Girls. Some of these talented young women are demonstrating their skills in programs such as the Women's Hackathon and the Project Lead The Way (PLTW) Engineering pathway. Other girls are learning coding, electronics, design, and science in classrooms across the district.

In October, six students from Carlsbad High School (CHS) and Sage Creek High School (SCHS) competed in the Women's Hackathon held at Cal State University San Marcos. In the Hackathon, high school girls and college women work in teams to create technology solutions for selected nonprofit organizations, with the assistance of professionals from local industries who serve as mentors or judges

Teams from Carlsbad Unified won two of the top awards in the competition. Claire Perhach, Kendall Schubert, and Margaret Yao from SCHS—and Hannah Ghassemian, Hanna Hong, and Kayla Choi from CHS—used their analytical and coding skills to solve a problem for a nonprofit organization, and then did a presentation on their solution to a team of judges.

The Foundation for Animal Care and Education, a nonprofit that

provides grants for people unable to afford emergency or critical care for their pets, wanted to establish a forum on its website to give those people information about pet services in their area. Claire Perhach, Margaret Yao, Hannah Ghassemian, Hanna Hong, and Kayla Choi, through brainstorming and with some guidance from their mentors, were able to use Facebook Artificial Intelligence (AI) technology to set up a "chat bot" that could provide location access information to users based on keywords.

Kendall Schubert's team, made up of students from CSUSM and other high schools, also won in its category. The team took on a challenge for Hera Labs, a nonprofit that helps women launch and scale their businesses. The team's project was to create a small website to help keep Hera Lab's clients on track.

Dr. Saied Moezzi, who teaches AP Computer Science at CHS and Computer Science Principles at SCHS, says, "These students deserve to be recognized for their successes in the Hackathon. They are hardworking students who excelled in a field of top students from across the county."

Physics and Engineering teacher James Fieberg is proud of the girls in his 4th year Project Lead The Way Engineering class. There, groups of students are creating innovative solutions to well-researched problems. For example, Bonnie Brasher and Zyra Kingston are working with other students to design a cheaper version of noise canceling headphones. As Bonnie says, "The best part of PLTW is that what we learn is applicable to getting jobs and being ready for college. There are lots of interesting internships and field trips." Bonnie wants to study aerospace and mechanical engineering in college. Zyra is interested in mechanical, architectural, or civil engineering.

Kirsten Steele and Keely Hsieh's group is designing a hydration monitor that fits on your arm and, using bioelectrical impedance analysis, measures how much water is in your fat/ skin. The monitor transmits through bluetooth, so you can read the results on a smartphone app. A runner or a laborer who works in the hot sun would be warned if they became seriously dehydrated. Kirsten would like to study mechanical engineering. Keely is interested in mechanical and computer engineering and wants to be involved in design.

Sometimes it seems like research around the science of heart health is contradictory. Is dark chocolate heart-healthy or not? What about wine? What are the latest findings about meat and dairy with regard to heart health?

Poulina Uddin, MD, a cardiologist at **Scripps Clinic**, helps you cut through the confusion with time-honored advice to keep your heart healthy.

Lose excess weight 'The more extra weight you carry around, the harder your heart has to work just to get you through the day," says Dr. Uddin. Plus, excess weight increases the risk of high blood pressure, high cholesterol and type 2 diabetes, none of which bode well for your heart. For many people, just a few changes in eating and activity can result in significant weight loss. Others may need the structure and support of medical weight loss supervision, but the effort is worth it. Lose excess weight, and you'll not only generally look and feel better, you'll also have a healthier heart.

harm than good. Round out your meals with whole grains, low-fat or nonfat dairy products, and protein sources, such as fish, poultry, lean meats, legumes and beans. Minimize your intake of saturated fats, processed foods and "empty" calories — candy, cookies, chips, pastries and soft drinks that offer little by way of nutrition and lots of fat, sugar and salt.

3 Check your Cholesterol There are two kinds of blood cholesterol: LDL ("bad" cholesterol) and HDL ("good" cholesterol). A build-up of LDL cholesterol can clog your arteries, which increases your risk of heart attack or stroke. "Good" HDL cholesterol carries "bad" cholesterol away. Ask your doctor how often you should have your cholesterol levels checked. A low-fat diet and regular exercise can help keep your cholesterol levels where they should be. In some cases, if your cholesterol is elevated, your doctor may also prescribe cholesterol-management medication.

Talk to your doctor In addition to making lifestyle choices that benefit your heart, talk to your doctor about other risk factors that may influence your heart's health; for example, a family history of heart problems. Together, you and your doctor can assess your risk and determine a plan for optimal health. It may even include a few bites of chocolate and a glass of red wine.



NAFTA 2.0 creates freer, fairer economic growth

The United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA) underscores a renewed understating among the USMCA parties on the importance of our mutual trading relationships.

The objectives of the USMCA are to eliminate barriers to trade, promote conditions of fair competition, increase investment opportunities, provide adequate protection of intellectual property rights, establish effective procedures for implementing and applying the agreements and resolving disputes, and to further trilateral, regional and multilateral cooperation.

With the support of the Consulates General of Canada of San Francisco and Los Angeles and the Consulate General of Mexico in Sacramento, experts convened at the CalChamber for a thorough update and discussion on the agreement with more than 100 attendees.

USMCA Background

The California Chamber of Commerce actively supported the creation of the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA)



among the United States, Canada and Mexico, comprising 489.5 million people with combined annual trade with the United States being around \$1.139 trillion in 2017. In 2017, goods exports topped \$525.46 billion while goods imports totaled nearly \$614.02 billion.

President Donald J. Trump announced his intent to renegotiate NAFTA in Mav 2017. The negotiations started shortly thereafter, going through many rounds. In August 2018, the U.S. and Mexico reached a preliminary agreement, while the U.S. continued separate negotiations with Canada. In October, Canada and the U.S. came to an agreement right before a self-imposed deadline, reassuring the deal would remain trilateral. The pact was rebranded the United States-Mexico-Canada Agreement (USMCA).

Stability and Credibility

Consul General of Mexico in Sacramento, Ambassador Liliana Ferrer Silva told attendees that the USMCA provides stability and credibility for North American businesses and workers and will allow them to thrive and prosper.

"We are promoting, creating the best business environment possible for businesses to develop and grow in order to create and grow jobs," Ferrer said. "Trade is fundamental, we are integrated to the world's economy and Mexico has been able to grow in thanks to this integration."

Mexico continues to be California's No. 1 export market, purchasing 15.5 percent of all California exports. California exports to Mexico amounted to \$26.7 billion in 2017, a slight increase from 2016.

Mexico has remained the United States' second largest export market since 1995, with a total value of \$242 billion in 2017.

Building Things Together

Consul General Rana Sarkar provided a status update and insights about the approval process of the USMCA from a Canadian perspective.

"The point is not just that we have a joint economy, it's not just that we sell to each other, but we build things together," Sarkar said.

The United States and Canada enjoy the largest bilateral trade and investment relationship in the world. In 2017, two way trade in goods between Canada and the United

States topped \$582 billion. Exports to Canada were \$282.47 billion, making it the largest export destination for the U.S. According to the most recent figures, U.S. companies invested approximately \$353 billion into Canada and foreign direct investment from Canada into the U.S. was nearly \$453 billion in 2016. Canada has remained California's second largest export market since 2006, with a total value of over \$16.7 billion in 2017 (9.7 percent of all California exports), as well as exporting \$9.2 billion in services to Canada. California imports \$28.7 billion from Canada.

The original NAFTA, which came into force in 1994, helped create an economically influential and competitive regional market of 480 million consumers and a combined gross domestic product (GDP) of \$21 Trillion (US). Nine new chapters have been incorporated into the USMCA—covering modern-day trade challenges including digital trade, regulatory cooperation, and North American competitiveness.

These represent some much needed updates to the original agreement, Sarkar expressed.

2018 Updates to the Agreement

The USMCA deal improves access to Canada's dairy market for U.S. farmers, giving U.S. exporters an estimated additional 3.59% market share. It also provides for stronger intellectual property provisions, and tighter rules of origin for auto production according to the Trump administration.

The Chapter 19 disputesettlement mechanism remains untouched, as Canada fought for, although the investor-state dispute settlement will be phased out for Canada and restricted to four areas for Mexico.

Canada also agreed to raise the threshold for applying duties to crossborder purchases, which was a key demand from the United States. The new de minimis level will be C\$150 (\$117 USD) for customs duties, up from C\$20 (\$15 USD).

Steel and aluminum tariffs imposed earlier in 2018 will remain in effect and are being dealt with separately. However, an agreement in the new pact increases by 800,000 the number of passenger vehicles that come across the border from Canada without being subject to a likely 25% duty.


